THE TEAWARES STUDY COLLECTION was begun in the early 1970s. It became a serious endeavor in 1976 when we settled in Victoria. Amongst the shops, the auctions and the container trade this period was a field-day for collectors.

Our main interest was the Newhall factory with its graceful shapes and folk-like decoration. However, the Newhall pieces soon required a comparative context, hence examples from other factories were added.

With not much spare income and in the interest of a more comprehensive collection, we decided we could live with some imperfect pieces. This decision proved to be advantageous because many collectors of the old school snub damaged pieces, and the fashion of the day for Victoriana fortunately kept the new collectors away from our field. Imperfect or not, the specimens taught us about ceramic bodies, glazes and decoration. Thus, the value of the assemblage lies in the merit of its function as a study or 'hands on' collection.

The collection was largely gathered locally, with much enjoyment and enthusiasm, over the period of a decade. Especially during the early stages of collecting, one of the intriguing problems was matching published photographs and descriptions with actual specimens. When our collecting emphasis changed we were loathe to break up the collection. Instead, inspired by John's appreciation of personal collections donated to the U.B.C. Museum, we agreed to keep the collection in Victoria by donating it to the Maltwood Art Museum and Gallery.

It is our hope that students with an interest in ceramics, given the opportunity to handle authentic examples, will be inspired to contribute to the literature of art and social history. Further, we trust that the gift will encourage others to consider similar contributions and thereby enrich the University Collection.
